

Little Lovely Lola

12" x 12"

Cutting Instructions:

- 3 - 2 1/2" Squares for rose petals
- 3 - 2 7/8" Squares for rose petals
- 3 - 2 7/8" Squares for background
- 3 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Rectangles for background
- 3 - 1 1/2" Squares for background
- 3 - 1 1/2" Squares for Rosebud Center
- 1 - 4 1/2" background square
- 1 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" background
- 1 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" background
- 1 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" border
- 1 - 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" border

Additional Items:

- Scrap fabric for leaves
- 7" of rick rack for the stem



Piecing Instructions:

Start by making the center of the Rosebuds. Place the 1 1/2" squares of background and Rosebud Center fabrics right sides together and stitch. Press to the dark.

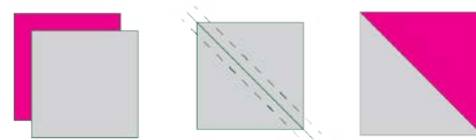
Then place the 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" background rectangles to the side of those sewn squares right sides together and stitch. These blocks should measure 2 1/2" square when complete.



Make 3 Blocks

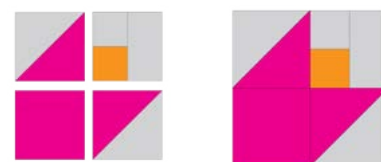
Create your half-square triangles for the Rose Petals.

Draw a diagonal line through the center of the 2 7/8" background squares. Layer each background square with the 2 7/8" Rose Petal squares, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" from either side of the drawn diagonal line on the background square. These blocks should measure 2 1/2" square when complete.



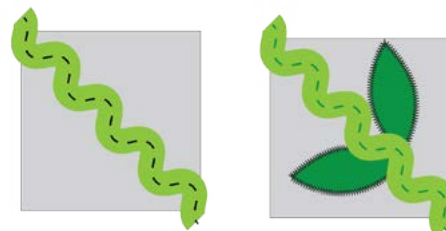
Make 6 Blocks

Once the above steps are complete you can assemble each rosebud. Use the above two units and the 2 1/2" square of Rose petal fabric. Stitch the units together as shown.



Make 3 Blocks

Now create the stem unit. Layer your rick rack diagonally on the 4 1/2" background square. Before stitching in place cut and place one or two leaves and tuck under the stem placement. Using a zig zag stitch and a coordinatling thread, stitch the leaf(ves) in place. Then lay the rick rack in place and stitch through the center. For ease of stitching, place the edges of the rick rack into the block seam. You can trim excess after completion.

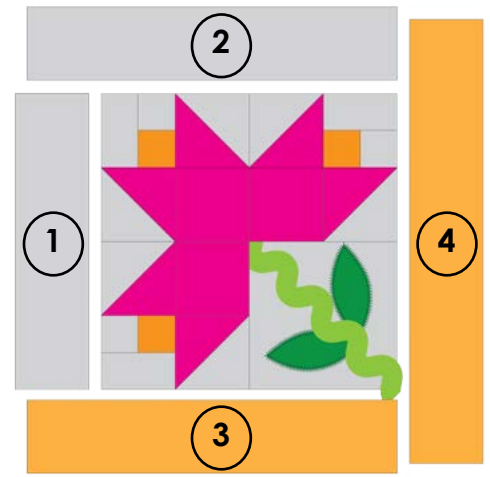


Make 1 Block

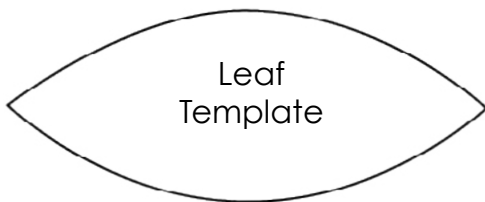
Assemble the pieces of the block. Be sure to turn each piece in the direction of the diagram. Then add the border strips in the order indicated in the diagram to complete your quilt top.

Once the block is complete you can transfer the phrase "Have patience... little Rosebud" onto the background strips of your block. Using your favorite embroidery stitch, hand stitch the embroidery onto the block.

Once complete, quilt as desired and add your binding.
