

# Little Lovely Lindy

15 x 15, or any size!

This pattern assumes knowledge of paper piecing. If you are not familiar with how to paper piece, see <http://www.craftsy.com/blog/2014/10/how-to-paper-piece/>

This quilt can be made any size by simply shrinking or enlarging the blocks; just be sure to trim them with a 1/4 inch seam allowance. As printed, the blocks are 3 inch squares, yielding a quilt that is 15 x 15 inches. The following fabric requirements are for that size:

Background: 2/3 yard

Accent: 1/4 yard

From Background fabric:

3 strips @ 5" each

Sub-cut into 25 5" squares


2 strips @ 3" each

Sub-cut into 12 3" x 5" rectangles

From accent fabric:

4 strips @ 2" each

Sub-cut into 29 2" x 5" rectangles



## Instructions:

Block A: Use the 3" x 5" background rectangles along with eight accent fabric strips to create four of Block A. Use leftover scraps or trimming for the small center triangles.

All other blocks: For each of the other blocks, take one of your 5" x 5" background rectangles and cut it in two, roughly replicating the angle of the accent strip. This will not only save fabric when paper piecing, but it will ensure that your outside edges are relatively close to on-grain. You need the following numbers of blocks:

Block B: 4

Block B (reverse): 4

Block C: 5

Block D: 2

Block D (reverse): 2






Block E: 2

Block E (reverse): 2

E	C	BR	B	C
D	B	A	A	BR
DR	BR	A	A	B
ER	C	B	BR	C
C	E	D	DR	ER

## Little Lovely Lindy

Print each block the appropriate number of times according to the block layout diagram. Copy blocks in reverse for the blocks labeled with an R (for example, BR is the reverse of block B).

Fabrics labeled with "A" are accent colors. Fabrics labeled "B" are background.

Note that these blocks do not have an outside seam allowance added; this is so you can resize how you'd like.

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
